Supplies

- A pad of drawing paper (11"x 14" or 14" x 17")
- 4B & 6B drawing pencils
- 4B graphite stick
- Pencil sharpener
- Design kneaded rubber eraser
- Plastic eraser
- Vis-à-vis Marker or Dry Erase Marker (low odor, thin line)

Also:

1. A printed a copy of a Picasso drawing. (See page 2). The image is included in the book Drawing on the Right Side of the Brain by Betty Edwards.
2. Access to a copy of the book. A free pdf version can be readily found on the internet, so purchasing a copy is not required. It's also available in both book and ebook form from some libraries.
3. using one's phone as a second camera is suggested so students can position it over their workspaces. This will allow the instructor to see and monitor progress during the drawing portion of the class. Instructions on how to connect your phone or tablet for this purpose will be sent to enrolled students.
